3. Innovative Farming in Jharkhand

Yamuna Kumari, a 23-year-old farmer, transformed her family's five-acre farm by adopting scientific techniques such as drip irrigation and polyhouse farming. Her diversified approach, including the cultivation of strawberries and marigolds, has resulted in an annual income of ₹10-11 lakh.
